Different types of cooperative audits

	Type of audit		
	Joint audit	Coordinated audit	Concurrent (or parallel) audit
Team	Joint audit team	National audit team per SAI with some coordination structure	National audit team per SAI
Audit approach (scope, questions, methods)	Identical for all participating SAIs	Coordinated/ harmonized to some degree, but differences between SAIs are possible	Chosen independently by each SAI
Report	Joint audit report only	National reports and/or joint audit report	National reports only

Current ideal of WGEPPP :

- Horizontal Coordinated Audit with same topic, same questions and same methods in order to compare the performance!
- Vertical Coordinated Audit about the same policy concerning two or more countries (conception, decisions, implementation and oversight in different countries). Examples: international development cooperation, export of waste, justice cooperation, environmental protection in a region that involves several countries, etc.

Have you ever participated in an audit involving two or more countries? If so, on which topics and with how many countries?

- 4 concurrent audits; topics: 3 on environmental topics, 1 on educational topic; number of involved countries: 3 audits with another country, 1 audit with two other countries
- 3 cooperative audits : 2 on environmental topics (15, 12 countries), 1 on educational topic (3)
- 4 joint, cooperative, coordinated audits : 3 on environmental topics (5, 15, 12 countries), 1 on social topic (7)
- 3 joint audits : on activities of international organisation (as members of the organisation)
- 3 cooperative audits (1 on environmental topic , 12 countries), 1 on social topic (15), 1 on tax topic (2)

Small survey

What were the main benefits of these cooperation?

- **Results of the audit:** better recommendations by learning from the policies and their implementation in other countries, by enforcing audit findings through benchmarking. Increasing the credibility of the report
- **SAI:** ameliorating regulation, audit approaches, audit methods by learning the practices from other SAI
- **Personal**: networking, sharing ideas, exchange of experiences, professional improvement of auditors

Small survey

What were the main difficulties?

- Difficulties and sometimes impossibility to compare due to the profound differences between the systems, even if the audit is based on a common detailed audit program,
- Difficulties at the beginning of the audit while we decide the audit framework. It is difficult to design a common audit framework as each SAI has its own features.
- Due to different systems of audits, to qualification of auditors, to political sensitivities, difference of opinion between different auditors.
- In order to achieve consensus between different SAIs may compromise quality of audit reports.

Topics for Horizontal Coordinated Audit

Flood Relief Fund 2022 received from government of Pakistan and from various International Development Partners and donor organizations to the Federal and Provincial Governments. Foreign Aided Projects (Executing Agency = Federal / Provincial Governments). Climate Change issues and the Forest Departments under the jurisdiction of different provincial governments.

Pricing in public health (medical services, drugs, others) - technical competences of authorities Forest management and climate change Medication of old people in institution Quality of neonatology service

Promotion of electro-mobility – subsidizing scooter, cars – coordination – infrastructure of electricity tanking (India) Fight against money laundering

Electronic waste Regulation and enforcement

Equity, diversity and inclusion (harassment, etc.) in public administration – implementation whistleblowing (Brazil, Chili)
