Operational objectives, derived from strategy

- 1. Encouraging working together
- 2. Strengthening methodological knowledge at SAI
- 3. Providing platform(s) for pragmatic information and knowledge exchange
- 4. Intensifying contact with relevant partners (e. g. PAS, research)
- 5. Raising transparency about WGEPPP activities

Decision on a project group on « Assessing the impact of performance audits »



Outcome of last meeting in Oct 24: Continue working on this subject with the aim of having a sustainable and widely applicable basis for SAI's work in the area.

Update / proposed steps as of 16 April 24:

- 1. Latest by end of June 2024, get consent of the Working Group on desirable outcome in form of an "assessment framework" (product name to be defined) and have project team (consisting of three to four SAI) defined.
 - SAIs Lithuania, Madagascar and Spain have expressed their interest in participating
 - It requires buy-in from a significant number of members, 18 SAI are represented today. Your vote please: launch this activity or not?
- 2. The Project team would draft a framework and circulate it to all SAIs for comments and discussions during the next WGEPPP forum in 2025. The draft framework would ideally consist of a few broad areas and specific Key Performance indicators (KPIs) and their description under each of these broad areas.
- 3. Simultaneously, we would call for case studies/examples of evaluations done by SAIs for specific Performance Audits. This would then help us to fine-tune/expand the framework further.

Decision on a project group on « Assessing the impact of performance audits »

WGEPPP Meeting / annual / participants: people in charge of performance audits incl. evaluations from WGEPPP members (1 day)

What is missing, what can we improve?



What is missing, what can we improve?

- Working Group should create more formalized reports, guidelines and other tools for SAI
- Working Group should consider how the consultation work of methodologists can be strengthened
- Working Group should consider how it can increase its visibility, also outside the members and observers, e.g. vis-à-vis other SAI
- Development of e.g. econometric models (such as GAO, NAO UK) that SAIs can use, e.g. to assess the effectiveness of SAIs. Otherwise, increasingly share the practices of SAIs so that it is easier to see how this is done in other countries (possibly supported by a sharing platform on the Internet site)
- Working Group should also work with evaluators and performance auditors outside of SAI, e.g. practitioners from the private sector, academics.
- Working Group members should strive to build capacity services with each other, e. g. providing technical assistance
- At meetings, use more case studies rather than presentation of (often) institution-specific processes
